Recycling News

Automated recycling has arrived! Last month, City residents received two new 96-gallon containers — gray for recyclable material and green for yard trimmings.

If you consistently find that the new containers are not sufficient (particularly for yard trimmings, now that the summer fire season has officially arrived), you may obtain additional containers by calling the Integrated Waste Management (IWMS) office at 548-3916.

CCEA has received a few calls from people who are having a hard time maneuvering the new containers. You may request smaller (46-gallon) containers by calling the IWMS office.

Please remember that trash containers may not be placed out before 10:00am on the day prior to collection, and must be removed from the curb by 8:00pm on collection day.




