

MINUTES OF MEETING OF  
CHEVY CHASE ESTATES ASSOCIATION

A special meeting of the Chevy Chase Estates Association was held at the Chevy Chase Golf Club, City of Glendale, on June 22, 1939, dinner being served at 7:00 P.M. to forty-five members.

Business session was called at eight o'clock by President Loudon. Minutes of last special meeting of May 8th were read and approved as read.

Report made by Mrs. Knudsen on formation of Auxiliary, and final disposition of resolution regarding purchase of Golf Club by City of Glendale.

Report made by Sewer Committee regarding easement rights, restrictions, and financial ability to form sewer districts.

President Loudon called attention to fact that Security Bank intended to withdraw subsidizing of P. E. bus line. Also, advised that City of Glendale could not see a possible purchase of Golf Club as a municipal project at this time.

Sponsors of a new plan of operation for the Golf Club, Miss Dawn and Mr. Bender were introduced. They outlined a possible plan of leasing and purchase of the Club under private management. They expressed their intention of operating it as a private club, and outlined the type of social activities and general organization, including representation on their Board of Directors by our organization.

Motion made by Mr. Barr and seconded by Mr. Grace that the President appoint a committee to cooperate with Miss Dawn and Mr. Bender to formulate a membership pledge and club policy. Motion carried.

Committee appointed: Mrs. Knudsen, chairman, to be assisted by Women's Committee.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to enjoy some very fine dancing acts and a dance orchestra furnished by Miss Dawn and Mr. Bender.
