Trees Feature Chevy Chase Tract

A portion of beautiful Chevy Chase drive, which traverses the entire tract of the same name, is shown herewith, with the beautiful liveoaks and sycamores which border it for

more than a mile. The policy of the owner of this subdivision is to retain as many of the trees as possible with the development of the property.



The planning of a championship golf course upon a property which is covered with more than 5000 giant oaks and sycamore trees by William F. Bell, noted Southern, California golf architect, in

the planning of the new Chevy Chase golf links, according to Bert Farrar, owner of the 1600-acre residential subdivision which is to have this beautiful green expanse as its central feature.

Construction work at Chevy Chase has now progressed to the point where it is possible to trace the outline of each hole and although the fairways are of ample width it is now evident that they are to be lined with beautiful trees in almost every case. Most of the trees will be shaded by live oaks and the area set aside for the clubhouse grounds is particularly favored with a luxurious forest of gigantic trees.

Tree Lined Roads

Chevy Chase drive, which now traverses the entire property of Chevy Chase, according to Farrar, is lined with trees for almost its entire length of over two miles from the southwest gateway to the property to the northeast entrance. Landscaping plans for the property as a whole as well as on the individual homesites of recent purchasers here will be based on the preservation of the thick native growth of trees.

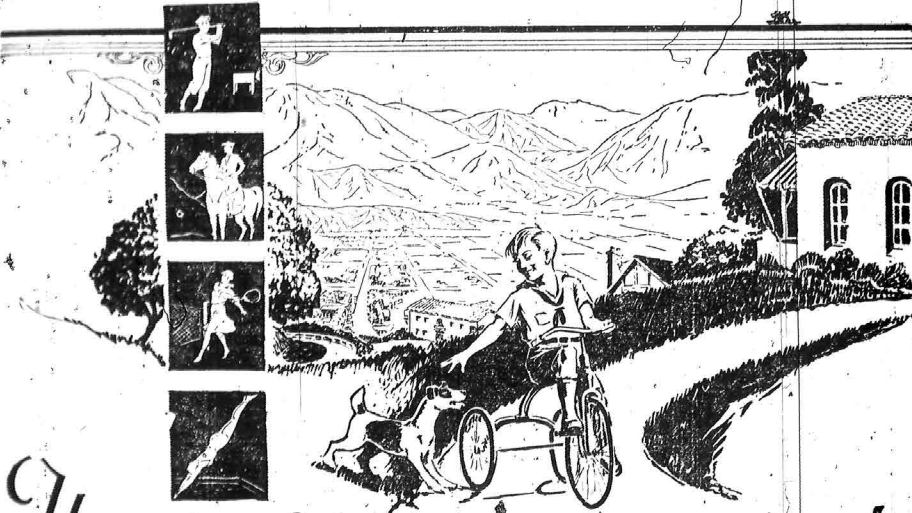
New areas of Chevy Chase are to be placed on the market by roads instead of by units according to a policy announced by Bert Farrar last week, following the successful sale of nearly all the homesites on Greenwick road, which was announced two weeks ago.

This policy fits in with the scheme of development of this beautiful residential community because drives within the Farrar property are winding under beautiful spreading oaks and sycamores and it is not practical to open up the usual square areas to development. New Drive

Edgewood road is the newest drive to be placed on the market, going on sale for the first time today. This beautiful curving avenue overlooks the golf course and much of the upper tree clad area of Chevy Chase. It is one block from the Chevy Chase Golf and Country club, which is now under construction. Work on both the golf course and the new 15,000,000 gallon reservoir, which is to supply water to all of Chevy Chase, now is rapidly progressing with scores of teams at work and a large crew of men laying the thirty inch water main that will be the inlet to the immense new reservoir.
